Morning Arrival

Breakfast is FREE for all students and begins at 7:30AM. Students may not be dropped off prior to 7:30AM unless they are signed up and attending Discovery Link. **School begins promptly at 8:00AM.** In the morning K-5 students will go directly to their classrooms beginning at 7:45AM. **The first bell rings at 7:55AM and the tardy bell rings at 8:00AM.**

**We ask that parents do not walk their students to their classroom door, we ask that you say goodbye at the main entrance. If you have a meeting with a

teacher, you must sign in at the main office and obtain a visitors badge.

Late Arrival

Once the tardy bell rings at 8:00AM, ALL students must enter through the main office to check in and obtain a late pass.

Dismissal

Students are dismissed at 3:00PM. Bus riders and students who attend Discovery Link or after school enrichments will be dismissed a few minutes before the bell. All students who are picked up will walk out to the playground area on the north side of the building with their classroom teacher. Teachers will wait on the playground until 3:15PM for pick-up. Students who are not picked up by then will then be walked into the office while the teacher attempts to call the family. All students must be picked up by 3:30PM.

School Security

Our number one priority at school, is safety of all students, staff and visitors. ALL doors remain locked during school hours. All visitors must buzz in at the main entrance, located on the east side of the building facing Lima St. All visitors will be required to provide a valid picture ID that will be scanned into our Raptor Security System. Visitors are required to wear their visitor badge at all times in a visible place and must check out in the main office when they depart.

Lunch

Students are welcome to bring their lunch from home or purchase lunch at school. If lunch is purchased at school, you can set up your students account through MySchoolBucks.com. This account is linked directly to the students ID number. **Helpful tip: practice your students 6 digit student ID number with them before the first day of school.** This number will follow them

through their education with Denver Public Schools.

We are a **Peanut Aware School**. Please talk with your student about not sharing food with anyone else and being sure to clean up their area and washing their hands.
